


UNIVERSITY MAP

- **1610** Galileo published the *Sidereus Nuncius*





- 1629 First University Library in Italy inaugurated
- 1678 First woman in the world to graduate
- **1848** Students took part in riots
- **1942** Biggest telescope in Europe

- 1945 Gold medal for military valour, owing to resistance against nazifascism
- **1985** first heart transplant operation in Italy
- **2004** Galilean School of Higher education estabilished
- 2014 Biodiversity Garden

- **2011 and 2015**: 1st ranking for research in Italy

FUNDING AND FEES

First cycle, second cycle, single cycle degrees

- Maximum tuition fees (without scholarships and waivers), academic year 2018/19:
- Group A <u>Humanistic</u>: euro 2.507,00
- Group B <u>Scientific</u>: euro 2.600,00
- Group C <u>Veterinary medicine</u>, <u>Geology</u>: euro 2.710,00
- Group D Distance learning courses: euro 1.858,00
- Group E Primary teacher education: euro 2.919,00

Amounts can be significantly waived (minimum fee: euro 561/a.y.) based on "Equivalent Economic Status Index – ISEE"

In addition to income and merit-based reductions, students may benefit from other funding opportunities, including scholarships and fee waivers.



SCHOLARSHIPS AND FEE-WAIVERS

• Padova International Excellence Scholarship Programme

Starting from a.y. 2018/19, the University of Padova will be offering a selected number of full scholarships to highly talented prospective students wishing to pursue a first-cycle or second-cycle degree taught in English at Padova. Amount of scholarship: max. tuition fee-waiver + euro 12.000 scholarship (gross amount).

In addition, UniPD offers **100 full tuition fee-waivers** to students enrolling in one of its degree courses completely held in English.

Regional Scholarships

The University of Padova, through the Veneto Region funding, supports lowincome students (both Italian and international) enrolling in first, single or second cycle degrees and Phd courses.



Evaluation of Research Quality (VQR) in Italy

 Ranked the best among 96 Italian universities in two consecutive assessments of the research quality (2004-2010, 2011-2014).

 Report by the National Agency for the Evaluation of Universities and Research Institutes – ANVUR, whose main goal is to assess the quality of scientific research conducted by universities and public and private research institutions supervised by the Ministry of Education.

RESEARCH: DEPARTMENT QUALITY

Results of the National Evaluation of Department Quality (May 2017)

- The Italian Ministry of University and Education has ranked the University Departments according to the quality of the research they perform
- 119 Departments in Italy have been ranked at full score (top quality, i.e., 100/100 score)
- University of Padova has 21 Top quality Departments out of 32: again, the First in Italy



DEPARTMENTS OF EXCELLENCE

January 2018

ANVUR (Italian National Agency for the Evaluation of University and Research Systems) selected **13 Departments of Excellence** to access 271 million euros per year for the period 2018-2022
