II. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**



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ARGENTINA

There are three sets of eligibility requirements, relating respectively to:

BOLIVIA

1. The actors submitting the application.

BRASILE

2. The actions submitted.

3. Eligible costs.

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COLOMBIA

The actors submitting the application.

COSTA RICA

The lead applicant, who submits the application, in order to be eligible for a grant, must:

CUBA

Be a legal entity;

FCUADOR

Be non-profit making;

EL SALVADOR

Be formally established in Bahamas;

GUATEMALA

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Be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action and not merely function as an intermediary;

Demonstrate economic-financial and technical project implementation capacity:

HONDURAS

 Must prove that its average annual income volume, in the last 3 years (2020 - 2022) is higher than the maximum budget of the present call;

ITALIA

 It must prove to have executed (implemented), in the last 5 years (2018) 2022), at least 2 projects supporting activities related to this request for proposal.

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Exclusion criteria

PARAGUAY

Co-applicants, affiliated or associated organisations are not eligible for this call for proposals.

REPUBBLICA

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Organisations whose authorised representative has received a final judgement or a final administrative decision for one of the following reasons are not eligible for this call:

DOMINICANA URUGUAY

bankruptcy, insolvency, or liquidation proceedings;

VENEZUELA

failure to comply with obligations relating to the payment of taxes or social security contributions;



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ARGENTINA

serious professional misconduct;

BOLIVIA

fraud;

BRASILE

corruption;

conduct connected with a criminal organisation;

CILE

money laundering or terrorist financing;

COLOMBIA

terrorist offences or offences related to terrorist activities;

COSTA RICA

child labour and trafficking in human beings;

CUBA

in the case of the creation and/or use of Shell companies;

FCUADOR

irregularities, i.e. cases of non-compliance with EU rules, standards and requirements concerning the spending of EU funds, with a potentially negative impact on the EU's financial interests.

EL SALVADOR

GUATEMALA Actions submitted.

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To be eligible, the actions proposed in the application must respond to the Objectives and priorities described in the Terms of Reference of the Call.

HONDURAS

Although not mandatory, special consideration will be given to proposals that:

ITALIA

Have a significant participation of women and young people on equal terms.

MESSICO

Promote innovative changes in an environmentally responsible manner.

NICARAGUA

Eligibility of costs

PANAMA **PARAGUAY**

The budget submitted shall constitute a cost estimate and an overall ceiling of eligible costs. Eligible costs shall be based on the actual costs incurred by the applicant during the period between the dates indicated in the grant contract.

PERÙ

Indirect costs incurred in implementing the action may be eligible in the budget of the application up to a limit of 5 % of the total estimated eligible direct costs.

REPUBBLICA DOMINICANA

The following costs are not considered eligible:

URUGUAY

Contributions in kind.

VENEZUELA

Debts and debt burden (interest).



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ARGENTINA

Bank charges for transfers to and from the Contracting Authority.

BOLIVIA

 Costs declared by the beneficiary and financed under another action or programme.

BRASILE

Losses due to currency exchange.

CILE

Costs of duties, taxes, and charges, including VAT, recoverable or deductible by the Organisation.

COLOMBIA

- Staff costs and supplies not strictly related to the logistical-operational activities foreseen in the Project.

COSTA RICA

- Purchases of real estate, vehicles or equipment not strictly related to the implementation of the intervention.

Proposals must be valid for at least 6 months.

Applications received, by any other means or for any reason, after the deadline will not be considered.

IV. CRITERIA AND MODALITIES FOR THE EVALUATION AND AWARD OF **PROPOSALS**

The evaluation of proposals will be carried out by an IILA Committee on the basis of the documentation submitted.

Administrative checks

The Committee will evaluate compliance with the submission deadlines and the documentation received, as required. Submissions who will not comply with the administrative check will not be passed on to the evaluation of the proposal.

Proposal evaluation

The IILA Evaluation Committee will assign scores within the maximum limits set out in

the table below, obtaining a final score for each applicant.

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Award of the grant

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The application with the highest score will be selected. On the basis of the resulting scores, a reserve list will be drawn up in the event of further availability of programme funds.

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The result will be published on IILA website, <u>www.iila.org</u>, and the successful applicant will be notified by e-mail.

PARAGUAY

In case the successful applicant is not available, IILA may decide to award the grant to the second-best proposal and so on, according to the reserve list.

REPUBBLICA DOMINICANA

The successful bidder must sign the grant contract within 30 days from the date of receipt and return it to IILA. If the contract is not signed and returned within the aforementioned period, IILA may award the contract to another participant or cancel
